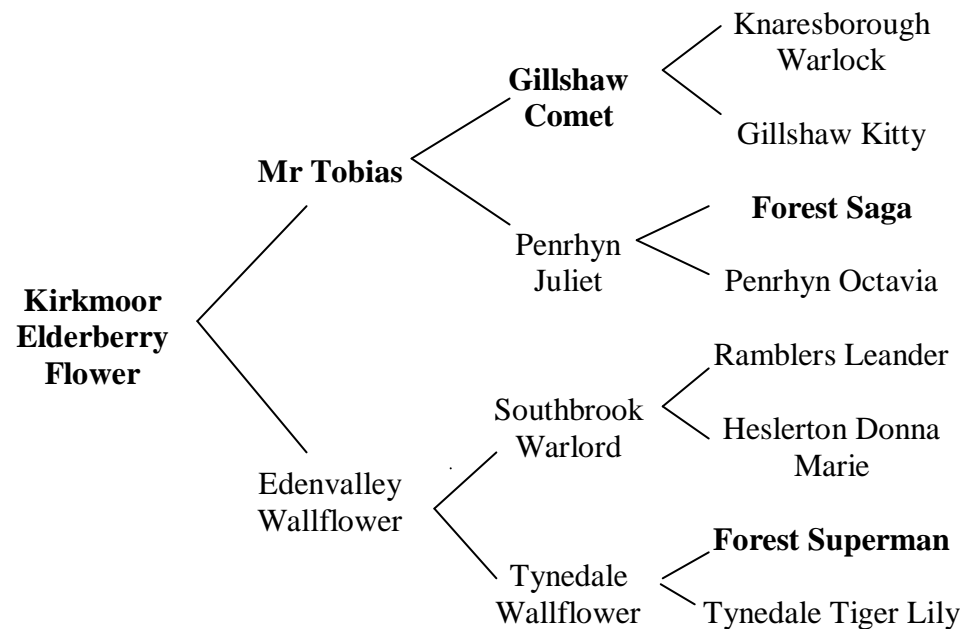

The Cleveland Bay is Britain's oldest breed and has been free from outside influences since the 18th Century. They have plenty of bone and substance, are hard, long lived and possess tremendous stamina.

They are always bay in colour, their action is level, free and long striding. Characteristically the breed is very bold and honest. It is a popular family horse and is most versatile having the ability to work well under saddle and harness.

Cleveland Bay breeding is evident in Sports Horses including Spring Pascal (promising young dressage star) and Arun Tor the Grand Prix Dressage Horse and Pembridge Minstrel a successful eventer.
